<p>1. <u>To receive update from previous minutes</u> There were no updates</p>	
<p>2. <u>To consider repairs to the hedgerow and Cost</u> Hedgerow damage behind the skateboard ramp was noted. Proposed by Cllr Wes Weeks, seconded by Cllr Jason Thomas and unanimously agreed that the hedgerow should be temporarily repaired using 35 metres of Heras fencing panels at an estimated cost of £650.</p>	WW
<p>3. <u>To consider the future of the Skate board ramp</u> Proposed by Cllr Wes Weeks, seconded by Cllr Jason Thomas that the skate board ramp should be removed from Pennard playing field. Prior to a vote on this resolution an amendment was added, specifying that in the event a decision was taken to remove the ramp, that it should be offered to another Community Council or organization. The ramp removal costs to be met by the recipient organization. A further amendment was proposed by Cllr Wes Weeks, seconded by Cllr Jason Thomas that, a time limit should be applied to finding an organization willing to take the ramp. A vote was taken with Cllrs Ralph Cook, Wes Weeks and Jason Thomas in favour of the amended proposal, Cllr Susan Rodaway against, and Cllr Lynda James abstaining.</p>	
<p>4. <u>To receive an update report on the faulty Children’s playground equipment</u> The Clerk confirmed that he has discussed the grinding noise which is heard with the Orbiter Roundabout with the supplier M/S Wickstead. The equipment was not manufactured by the Wickstead and once again they indicate that there will be a fee of £150 for the equipment supplier to arrange an On site inspection.
