Questions from the Public (limited to 10 minutes)

1. To agree Covid-19 policy for Burial Ground for recommendation to Full Council

Cllr Jeff Rogers referred to the proposed policy document which had been distributed prior to the meeting and gave some background information relating to it, in particular the number of mourners permitted to attend a funeral which seems to differ from area to area. The view from the local church was that 20 attendees was the maximum acceptable at this time.

Cllr Arthur Rogers joined the meeting at 7.40pm

The carpark was discussed and the whether or not spaces should be limited. It was agreed this was an extremely sensitive matter. Cllr Jeff Rogers suggested asking funeral directors to suggest to families that cars park in alternative spaces where possible, this was debated and each Councillor gave their views.

It was proposed that the acceptable number of attendees at a funeral at this time would be 20 excluding carers funeral staff and officiants and that the funeral director be advised that cars should park in alternate bays in the car park which has 22 spaces and that social distancing should be borne in mind at all times.
