A member of the public read out his views regarding item 1 of this meeting especially with regards to the comments on social media regarding the actions of Cllr James.

Cllr Rodaway said the issue was that Cllr James had been asked to consult with the community regarding the road names in her role as County Councillor had done so but had then chosen to ignore many of the suggestions.

1. 2020/201 To discuss road names for new development.

Cllr Hickery expressed his disappointment that Cllr James was not in attendance, he was one of the Councillors who had asked for this meeting following discussions at the Full Council meeting held on the 15th of October. Cllr James had consulted with the Community through the community facebook page and a large number of suggestions had been made by the community with many of them asking for welsh names, these responses been ignored in her suggestions for road names to the County Council.

This was discussed further with contributions made by member of the Public who felt strongly about the situation. Questions were raised about having further consultation which could be done using Survey Monkey. The Clerk was asked to write to the Head of Services at Swansea County Council to ask for a deadline date, whether the names were set in stone and if there was a possibility of having at least one Welsh name.

The discussion went on to look at other methods of consultation including leaflet drops and collecting points one of the members of the Public suggested using Google forms which she had used and would be able to liaise with the Clerk on. Cllr Marnell also suggested using the Schools Whatsapp group and website.
